(H)ighlight

After reading, highlight the verses that speak to you by writing out the following:

- · Name of the book
- Chapter and verse
- 1-3 word title (Why does this passage speak to me?)

(E)xplain

Engage the text & wrestle with its meaning. Questions

- Who was the passage written to?
- Why was it written
- What may God be communicating through this passage

(A)pply

Consider how to apply the text in Real Life:

- How can this passage help me?
- How can I apply this passage in my life today
- What is God saying to me?

(R)espond

Finally, respond to God. Make it sincere:

- Write out a prayer
- Commit to a certain action
- Who is God inviting me to be?
- What's my next step in becoming that person
